Dear Parent or Guardian:

This is a friendly reminder of some of the responsibilities of a Guntersville Aquacat parent.

Please have your child to practice on time!

Swimmers are signed up on a meet-by-meet basis. The sign-up sheets are on the bulletin board in the hallway of the pool area. Please be aware of whether your child is signed up or not. **Do not let your child sign up if they are not attending the meet. Conversely, make sure that your child is signed up beforehand for a meet in which they plan to participate.** A swimmer not showing up at a swim meet after committing to it shows a lack of respect for his or her fellow swimmers and coaches. If there is an emergency and your swimmer cannot come, **please contact Coach Debby immediately.**

Warm-ups are at 4:30 p.m. for home meets and 5:00 p.m. for away meets.

The coaching staff can only do so much to ensure your child's well being at a swim meet. Keep your child's activity at the swim meet to a minimum. Playing cards, reading, listening to music or playing video games all provide entertainment while allowing your swimmers to rest before their next race.

Swim meets require a lot of dedication from the parents. ***VOLUNTEER!!*** Swim meets are run by volunteer parents. We request that you "work" at least 1/2 of each home meet.

If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to talk to the coaches or any board member. We are here to make sure your child reaches his or her full potential this summer and hope they have a great time along the way.
